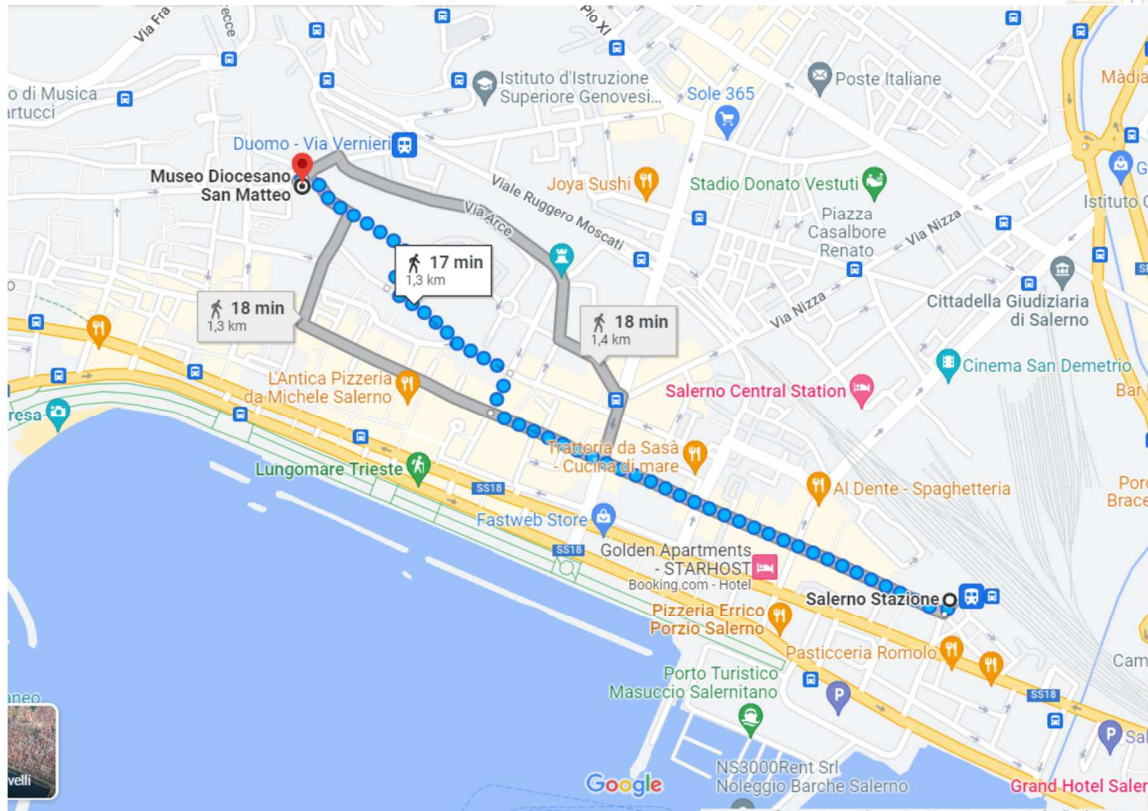
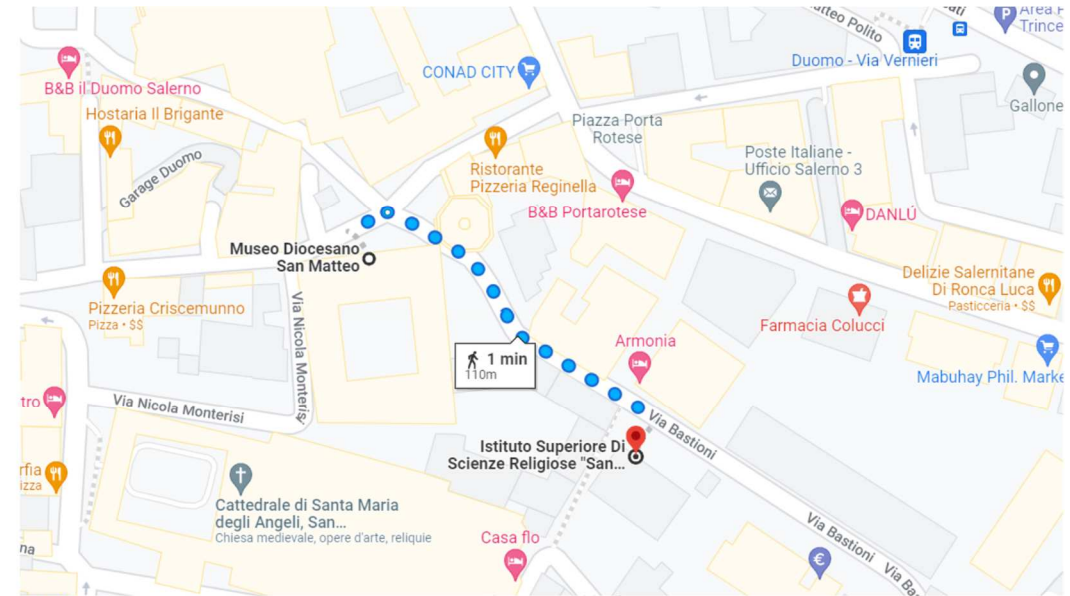


Information about the Conference venues:
